**2.7.1 Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall
institutional performance**

SSS Feedback Analysis

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

72% of the students have given their opinion as **85 to 100%** of the syllabus was covered in the class, **21%** of the students feedback is **70 to 84%** & **7%** of the students have replied as **55 to 69%** of the syllabus was covered in the class. **0%** of the student's feedback as **30 to 54%** & **below 30%**.

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

84% of the student's feedback is teachers prepare for the classes **thoroughly**, **14%** of the teachers prepare **satisfactorily** for the classess, **2%** of the teachers prepare **poorly** for the classes. **0%** of the student's opinion as **indifferently** & **won't teach at all**.

83% of student's feedback is **every time**, **11%** of the students replied as **usually** & **6%** student's opinion is **occasionally / sometimes**. **0%** of the student's say as **rarely** & **never**.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

74% of student's feedback is **fully**, **18%** of student's opinion is **reasonably** & **8%** of the student's say **partially**. **0%** of the student's response as **slightly** & **unable to**.

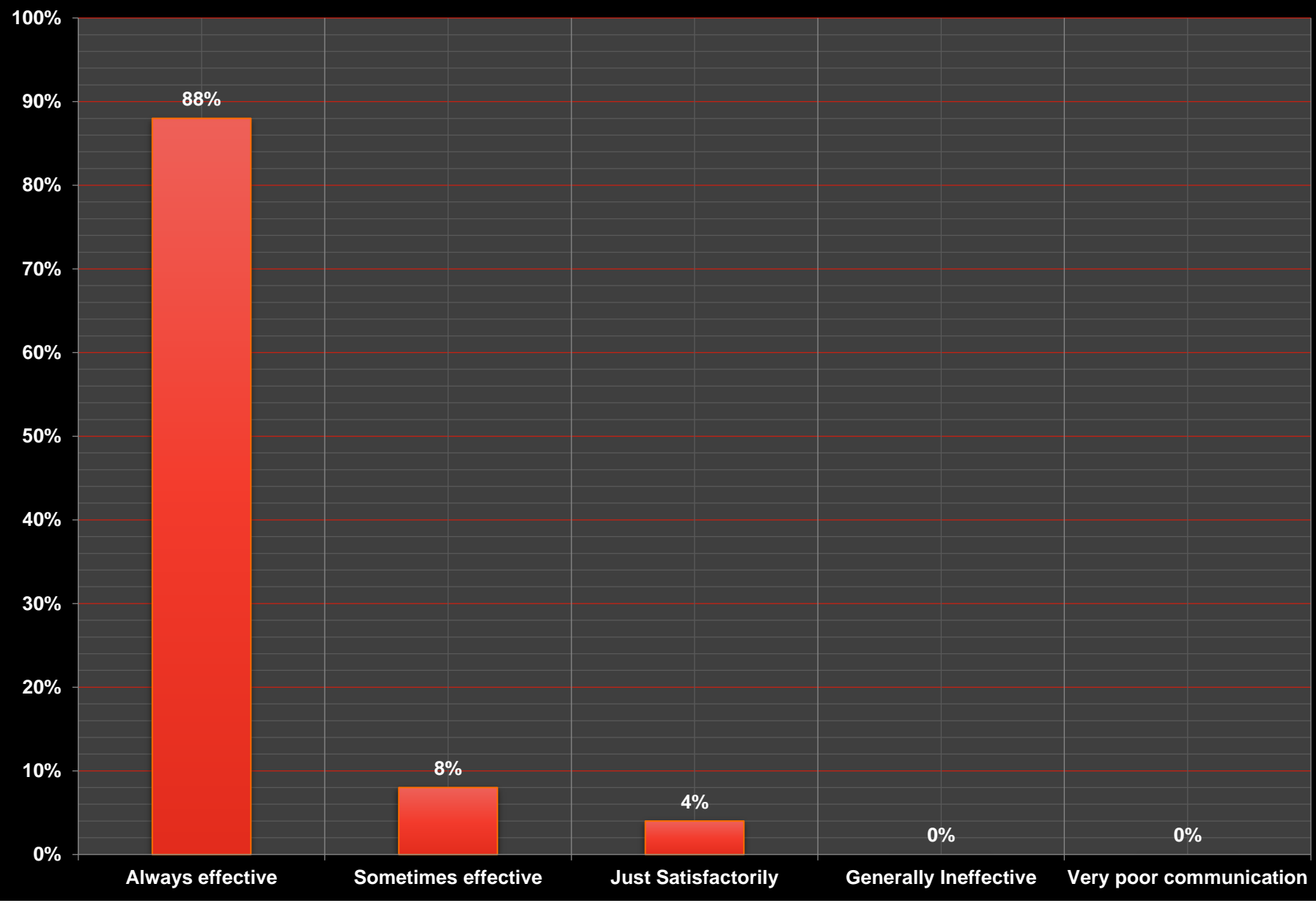

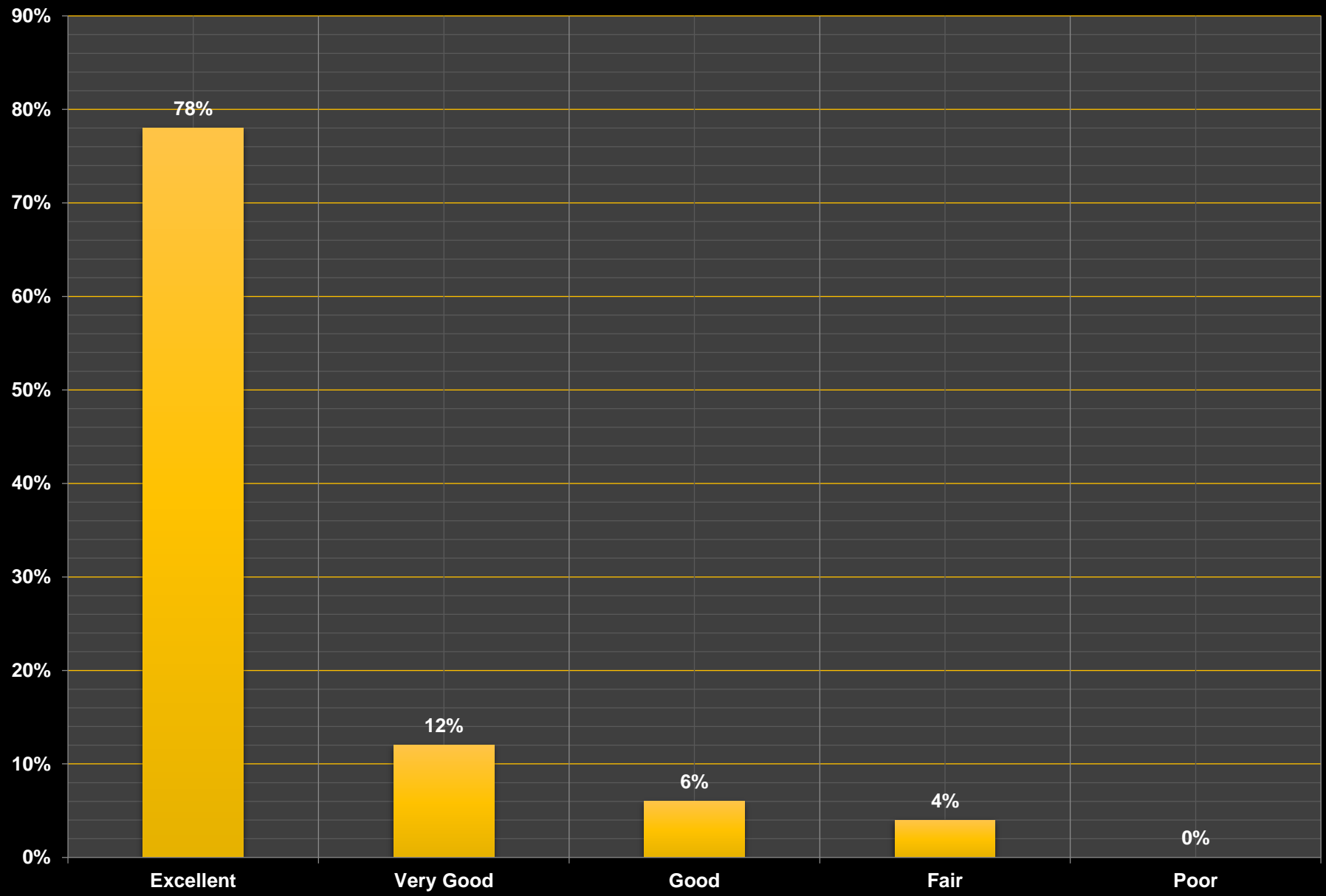

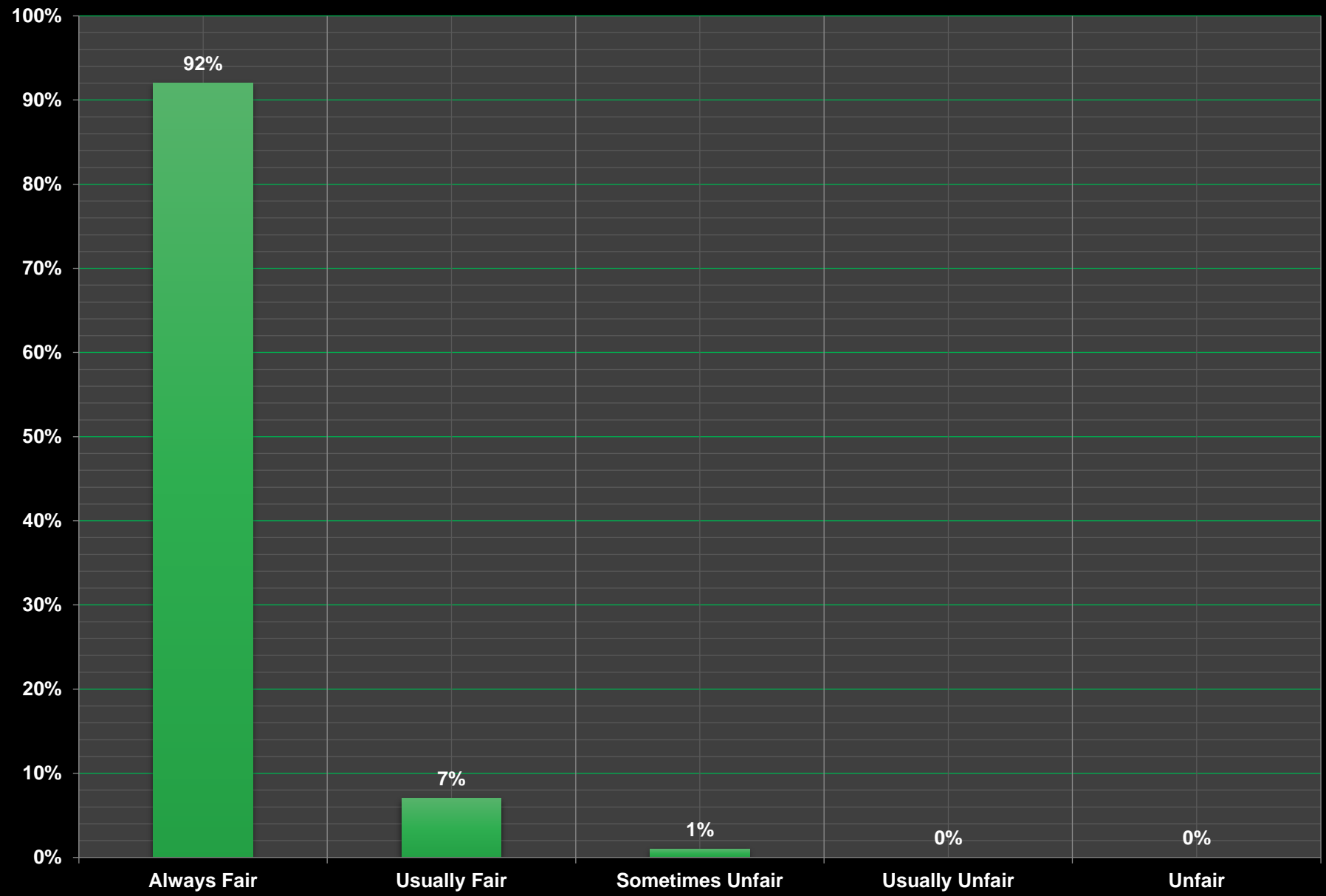

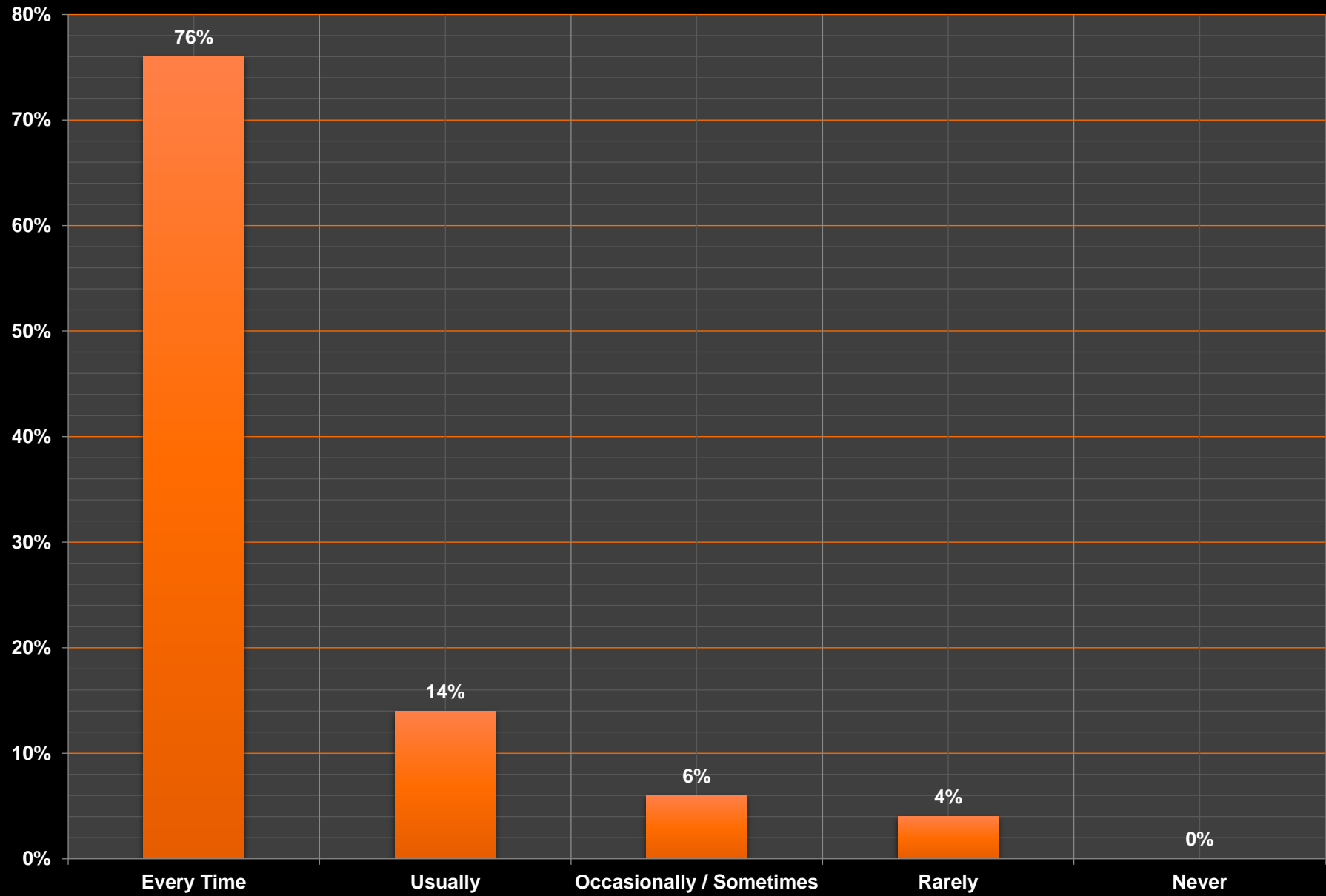

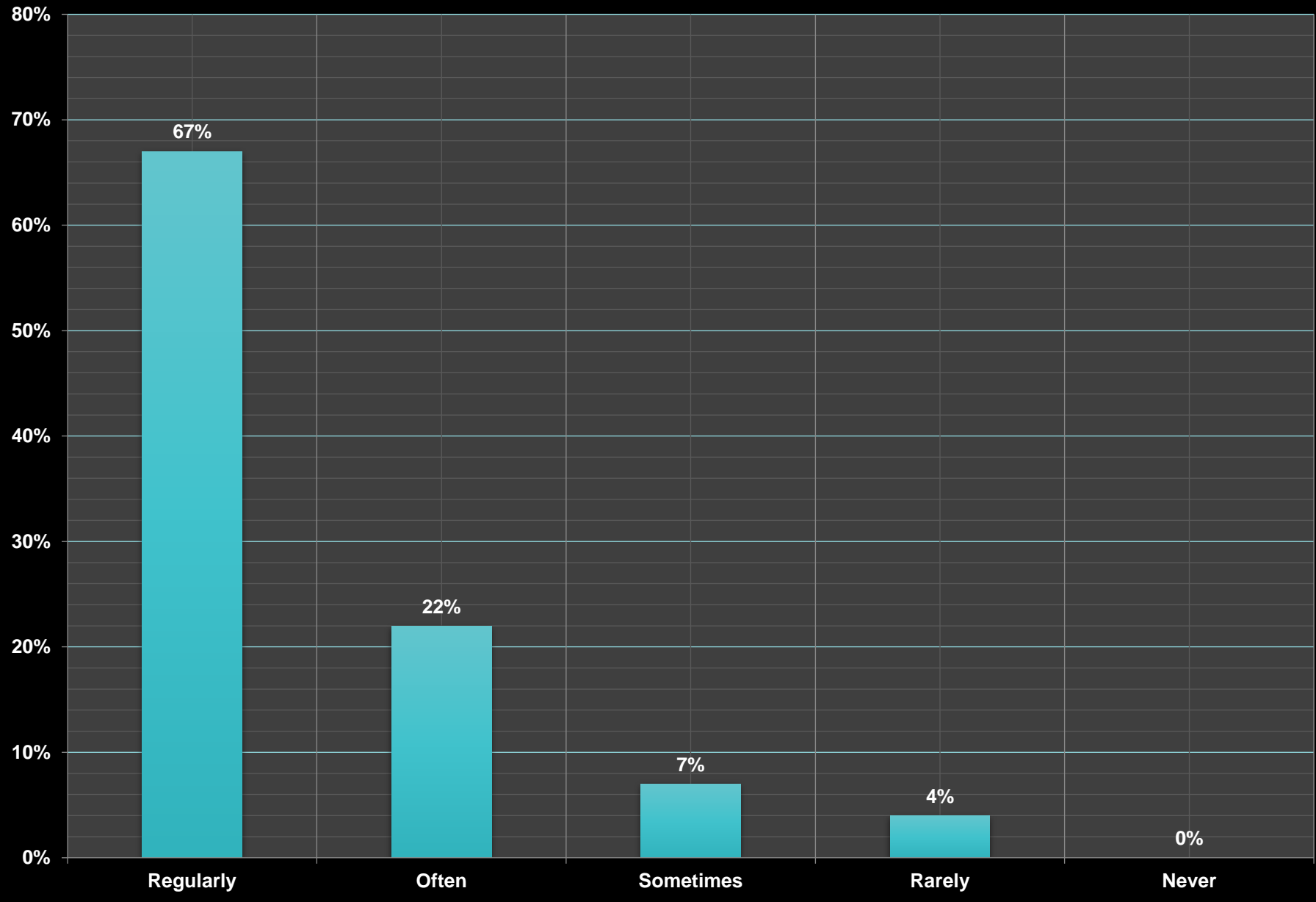

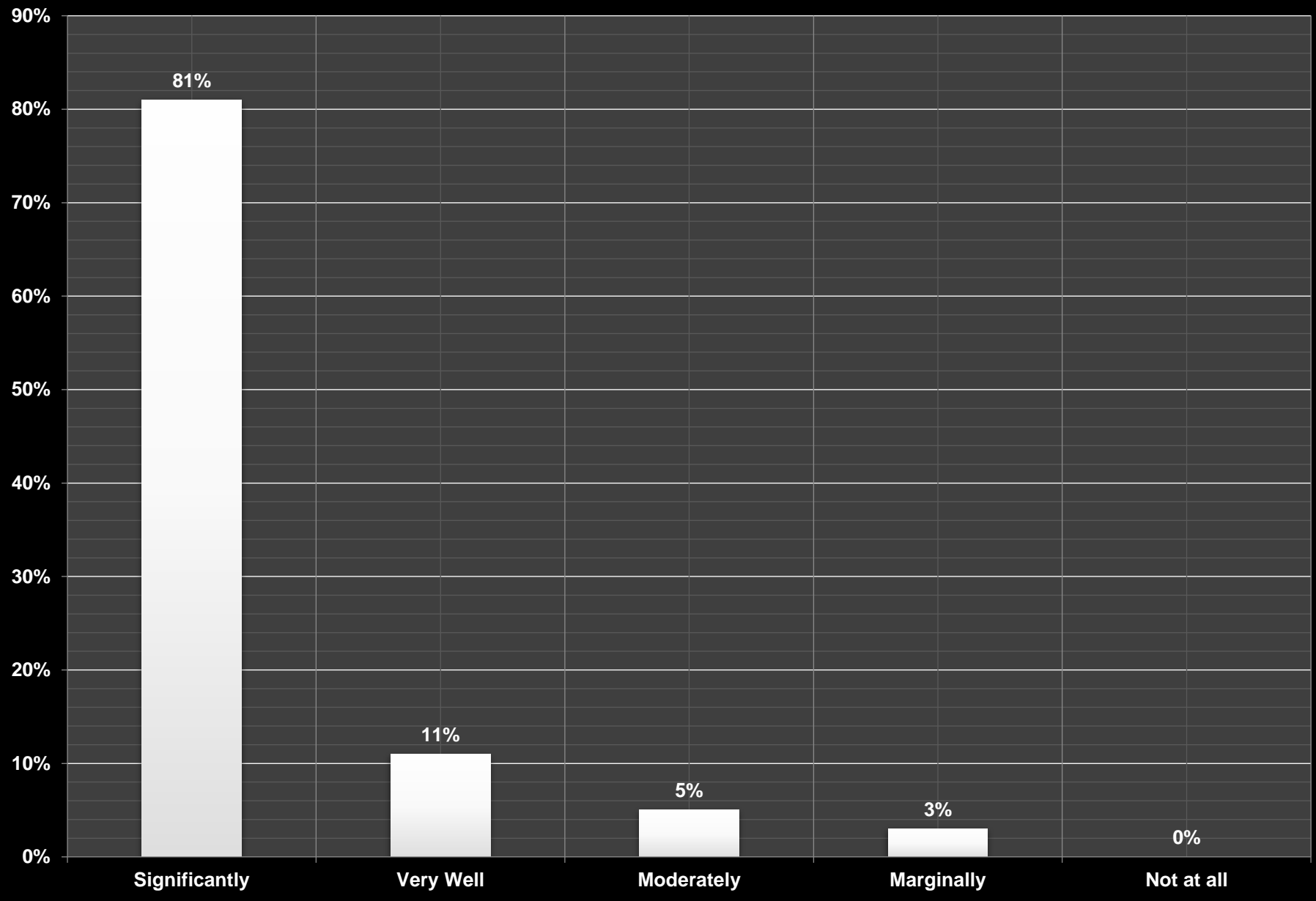

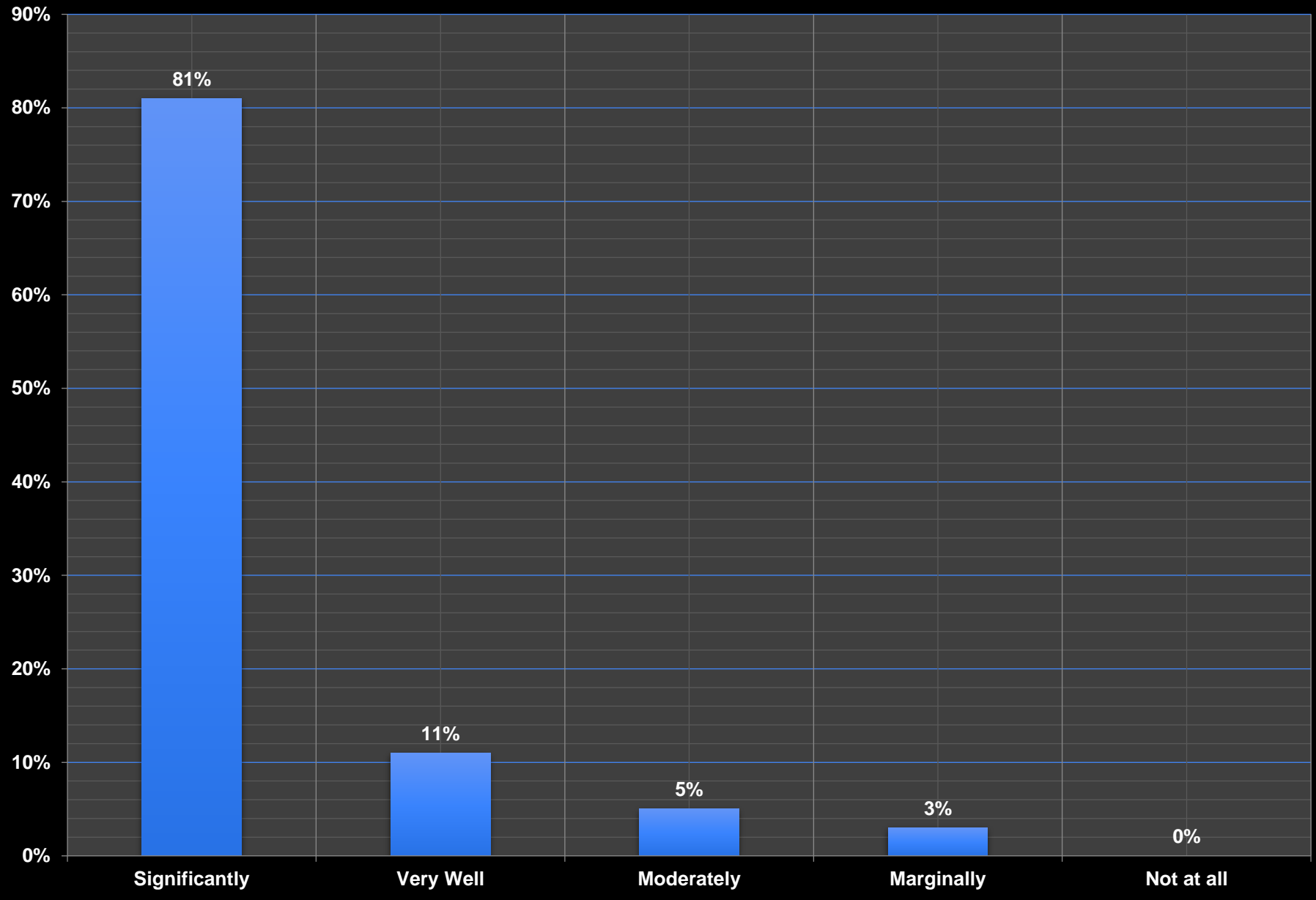

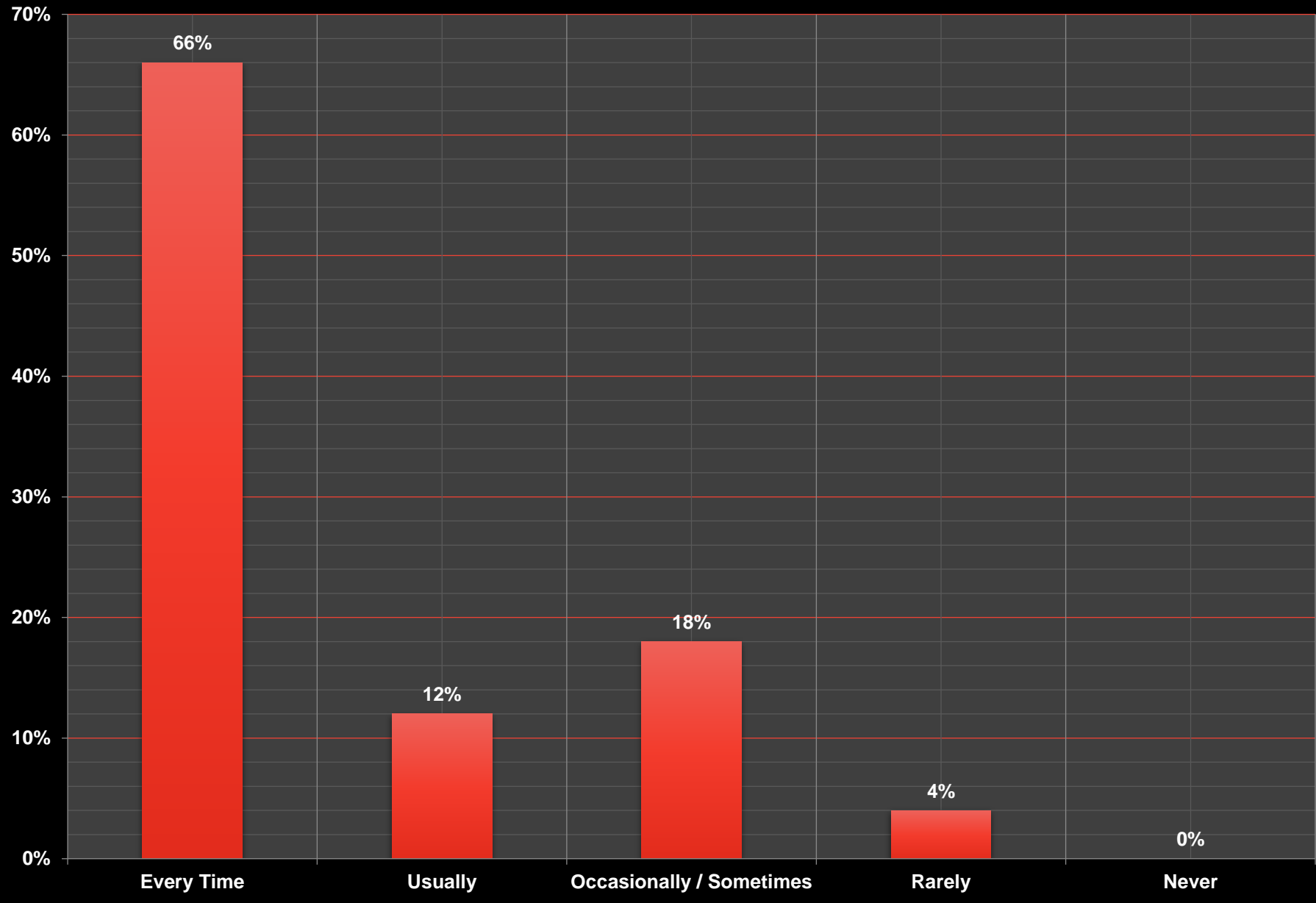

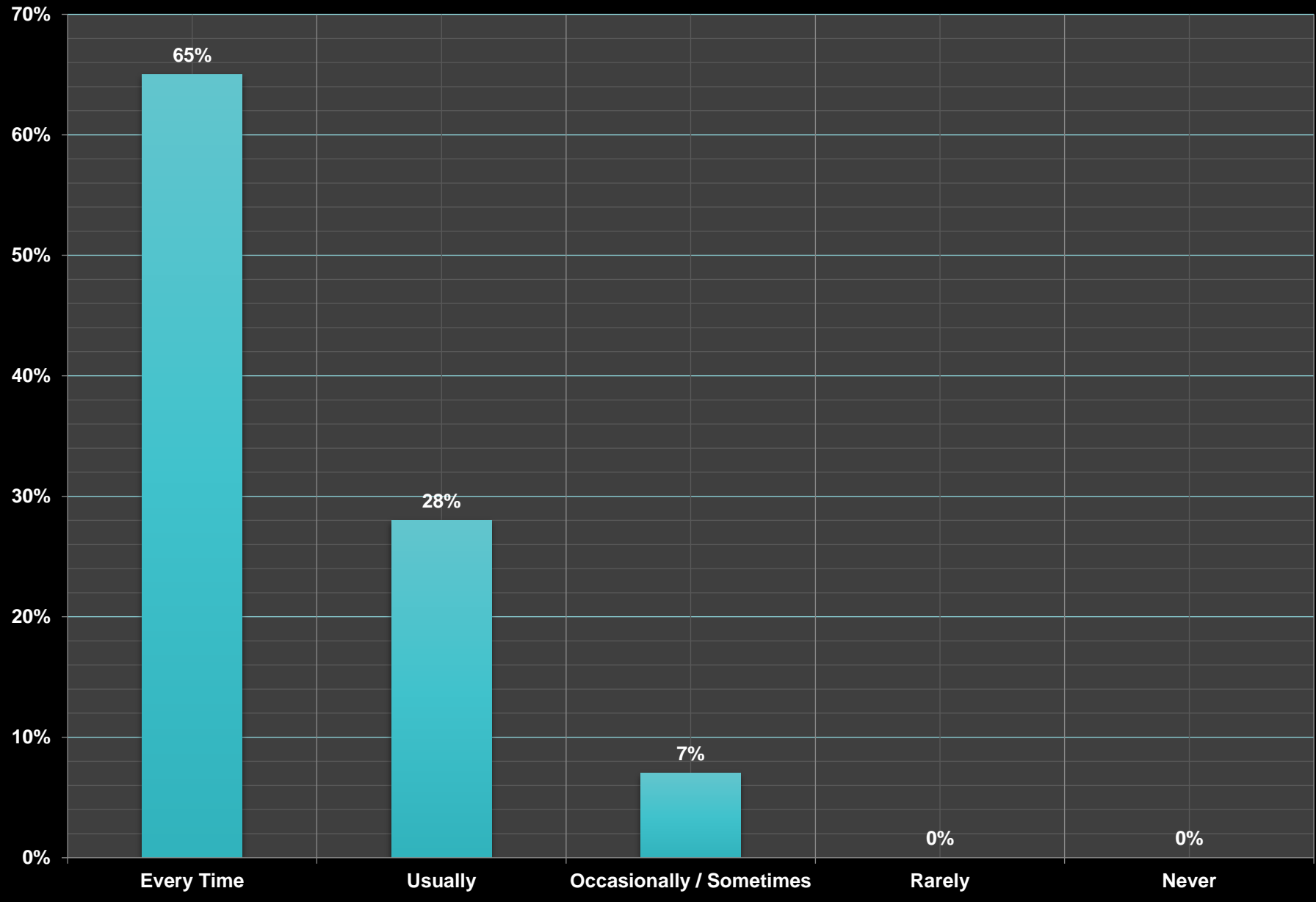

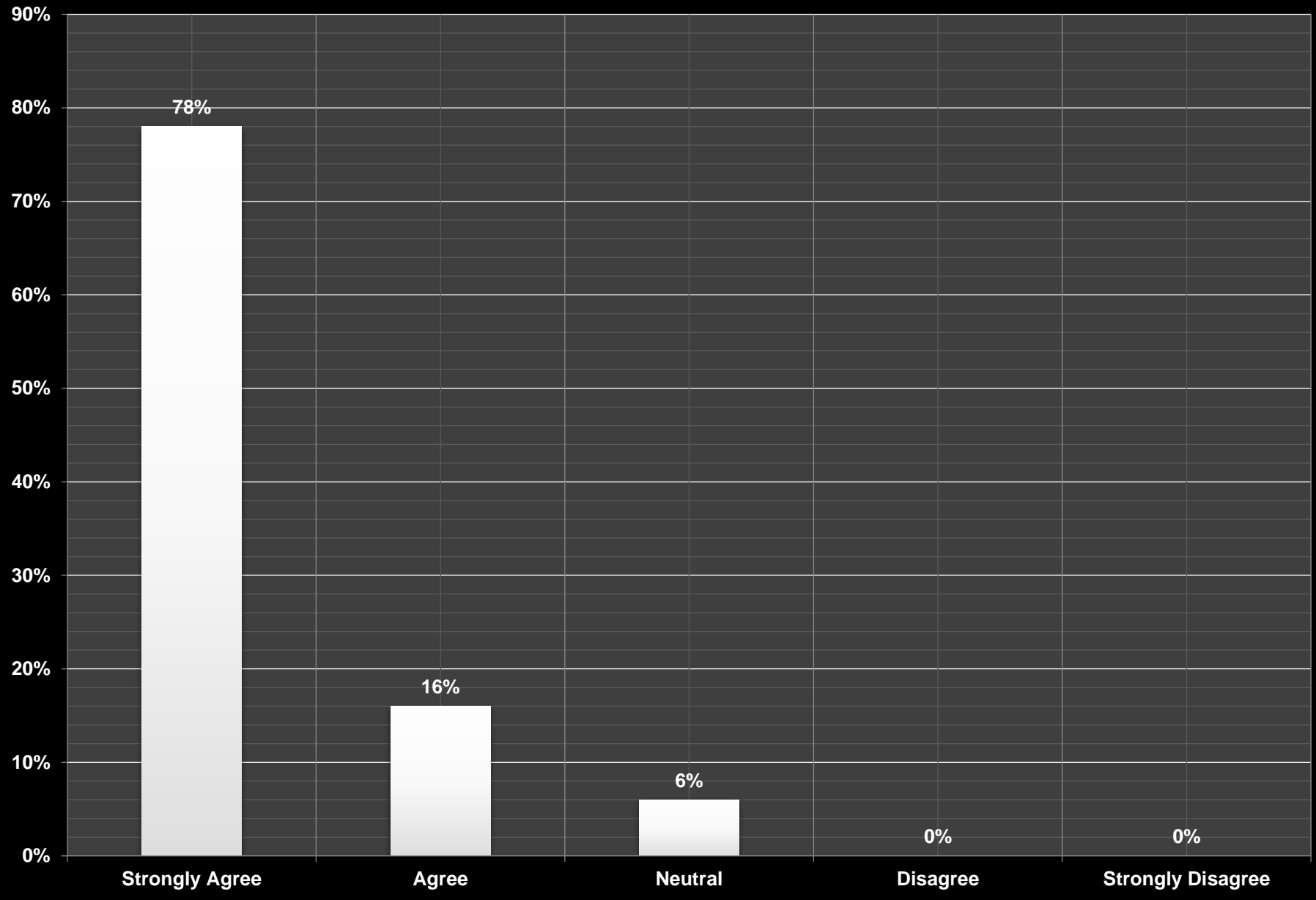

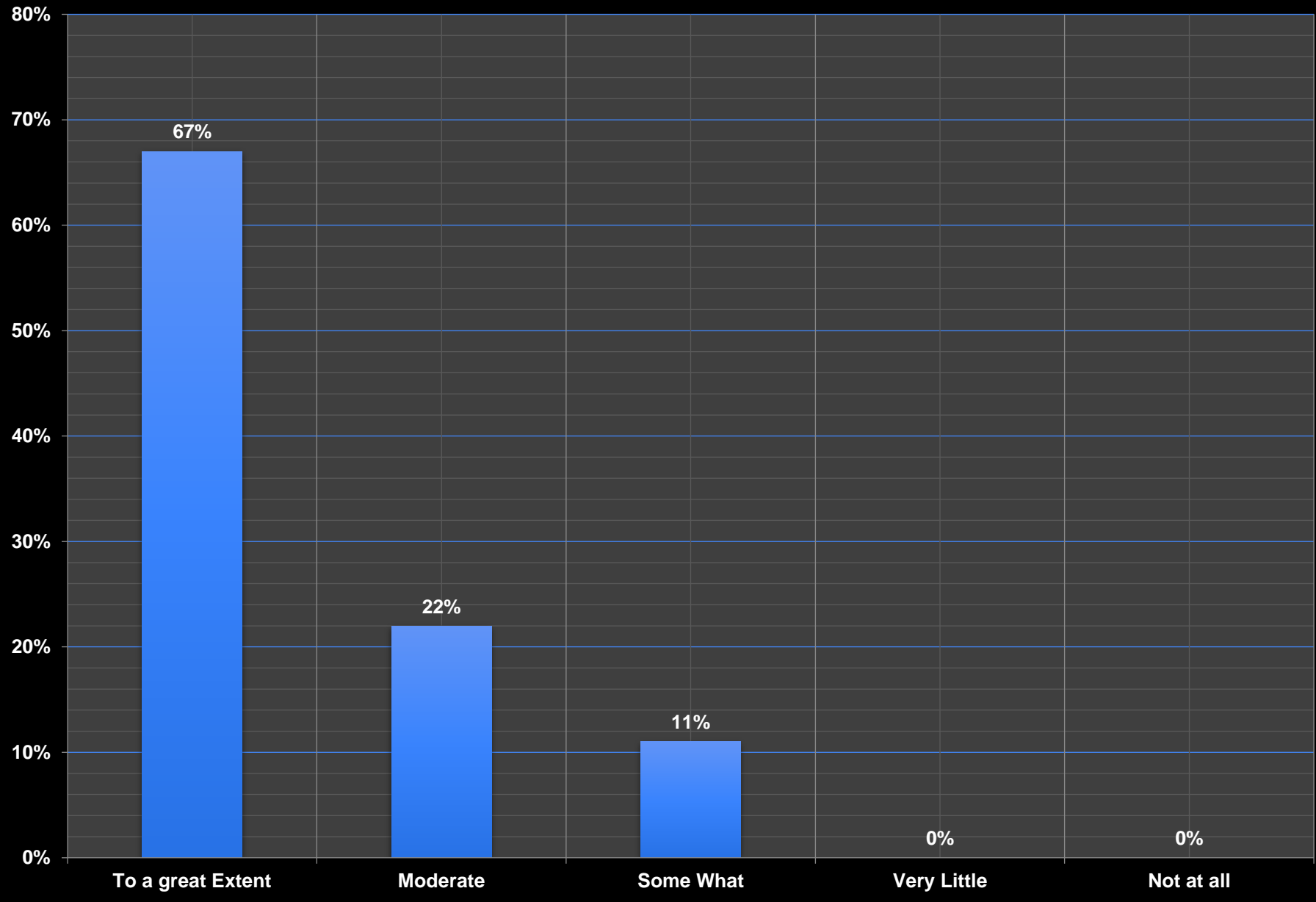

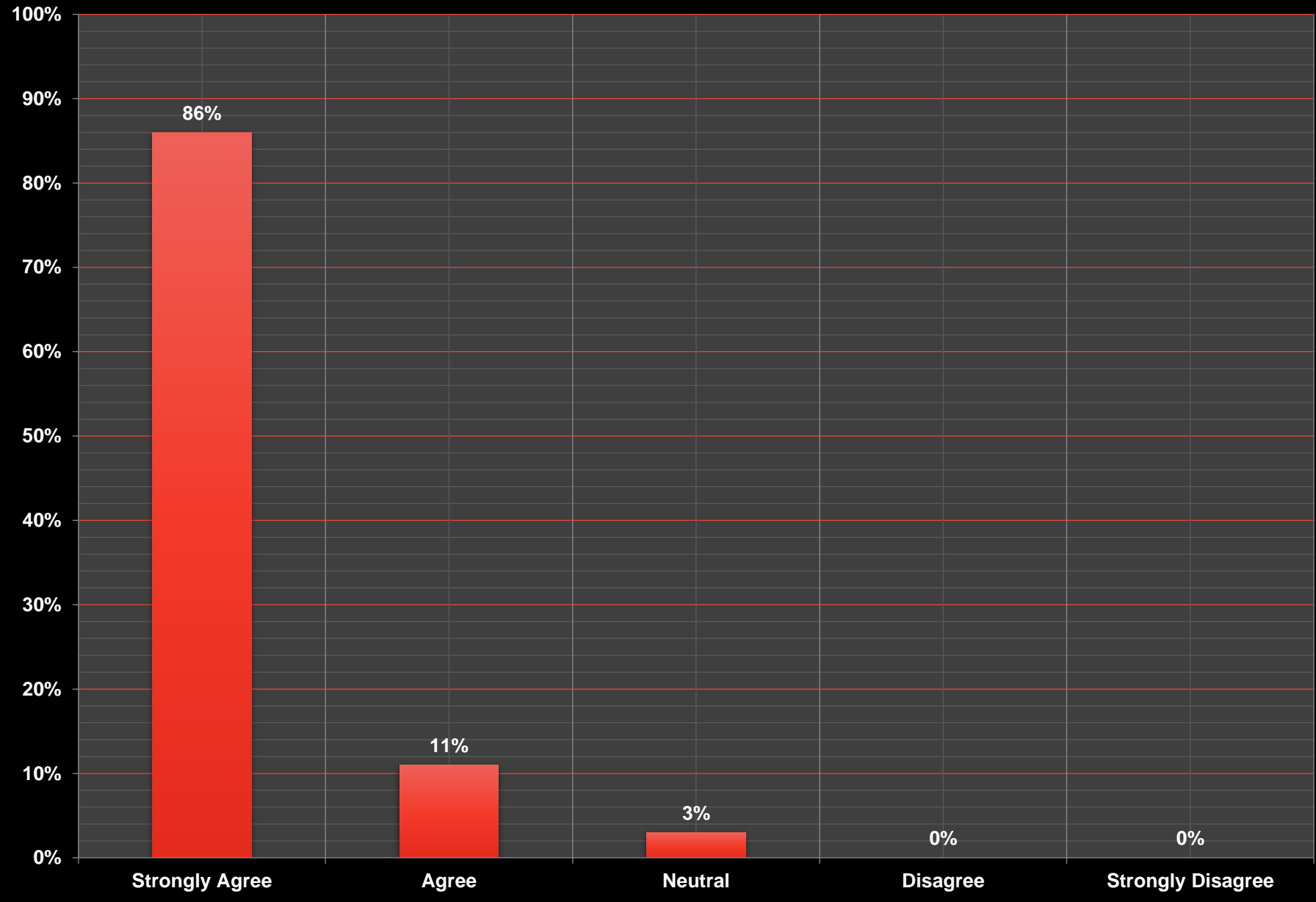

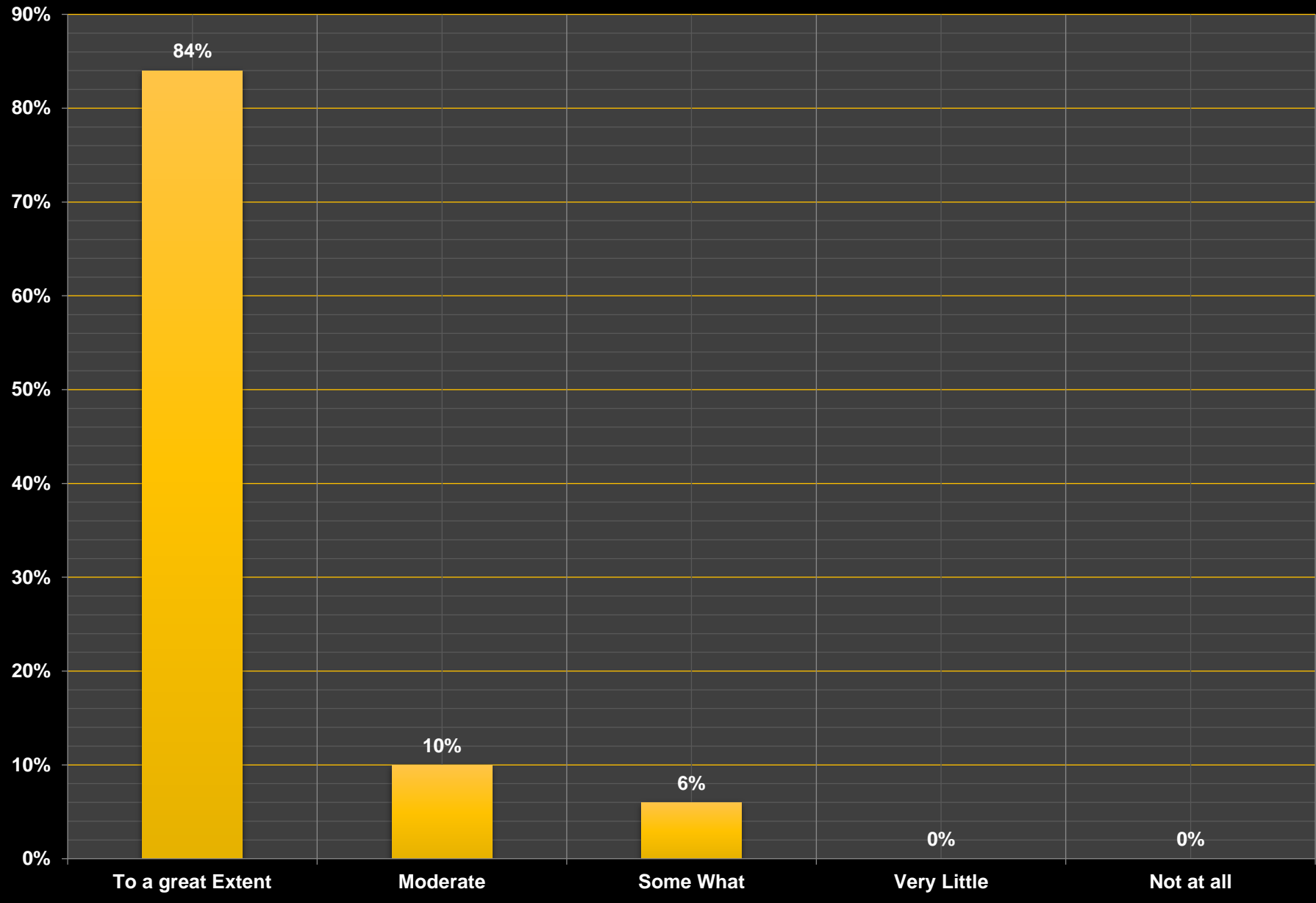

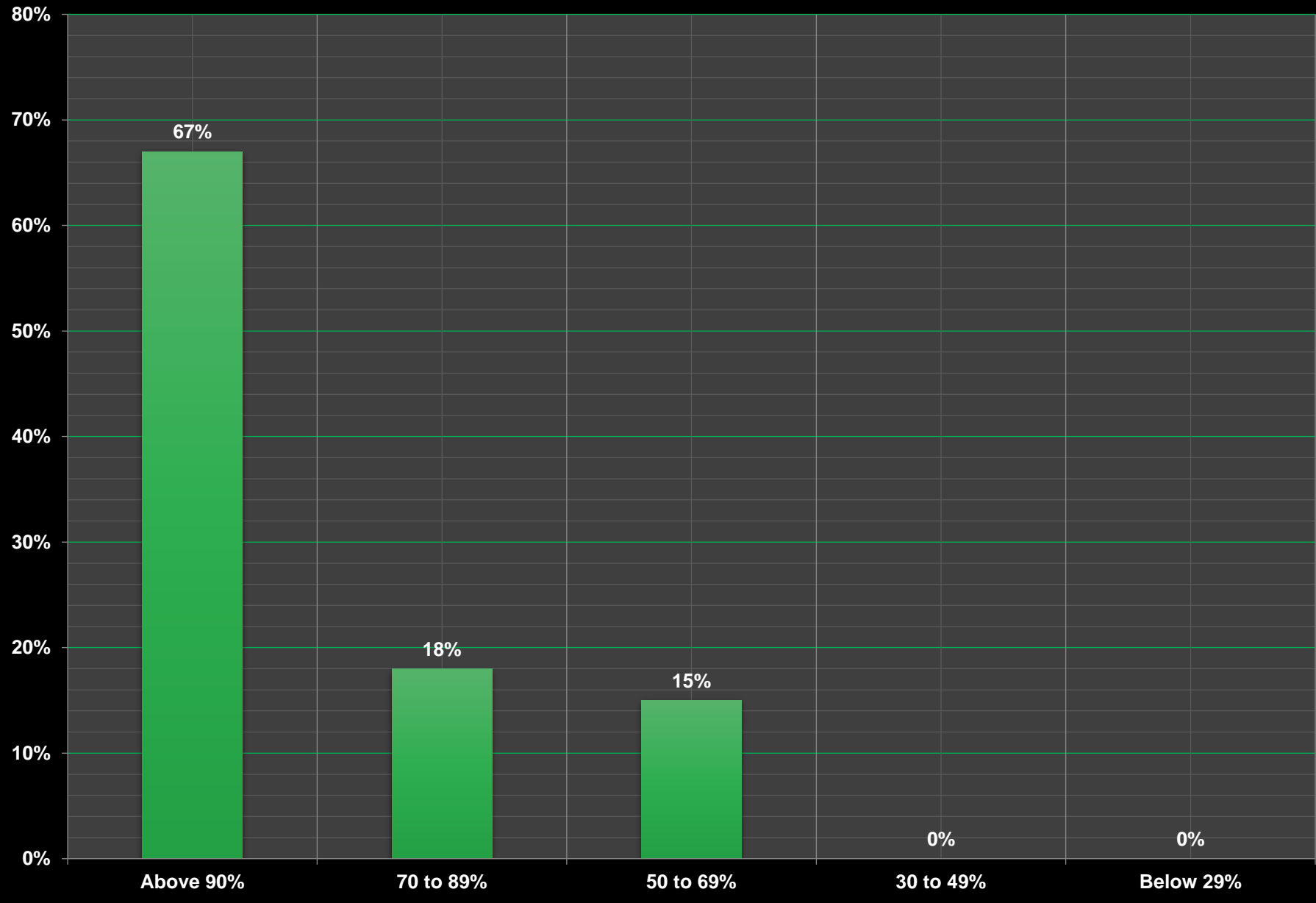
